


## STUDENTS BY LEVEL AND MODE OF STUDY, 2017/18







# UNEMPLOYMENT RATES AND MEDIAN SALARIES IN ENGLAND, 2018









## ACADEMIC STAFF BY NATIONALITY AND COST CENTRE, 2017/18




# INCOME AND SIZE OF HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS, 2016–17 TO 2017–18





